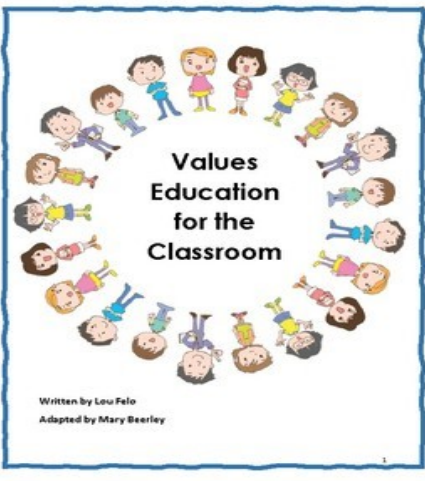

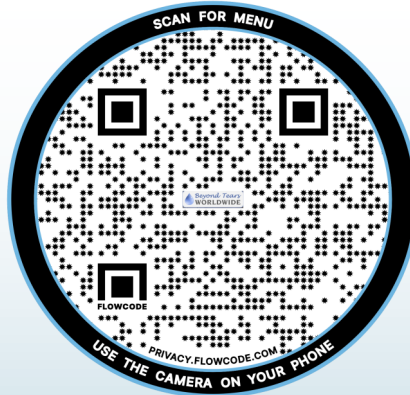

Unfortunately BTW has had to cancel our 2021 trips for Leh, Kashmir. Covid cases in India are now in a second wave and the Indian government is not issuing visas at this time. We are praying for better opportunities in 2022 and hope to be able to return to Leh both in May/June and July/August. Please let us know if you are interested in being a part of those teams. We have kept in touch with our friends in Leh and have been able to send them a few packages of hats, yarn and school supplies to encourage them and to let them know we are thinking of them. Would you please pray for them to desire to hear more about the love of Jesus when we visit them next year.

**BTW QR CODE**

A QR code (barcode) is a type of collection of numbers arranged into a fixed number of rows and columns, a matrix, invented in 1994 by the Japanese automotive company, Denso Wave. A bar-



code is a machine-readable optical label that contains information about the item to which it is attached. The BTW QR code has information that takes a person who scans the code directly to the BTW website; fast and simple (adapted from Wikipedia).

These days, the majority of QR Codes are scanned with a smartphone, although computers can also read them. There are tons of free apps for QR scanning for both Android and iOS (Apple) devices or any device that has a camera with an internet connection. Most often, you simply open

an app that supports QR code-reading and it automatically scans the QR Code with the touch of a button and reveals the information or directs you to a website instantaneously. Please use our BTW QR Code to connect you to the BTW website of activities and updates about our outreach and ministry.
