BTW Teams Through the Years

As the twentieth anniversary of the founding of BTW is approaching in 2022, we have been reviewing the many teams that have been sent out. We thought you would like to see what has been accomplished over these past two decades.

1997-2005 teams worked in Kosovo doing reconstruction of outlying village Lipjan, sharing construction with UNHCR of the largest sports centre in central Kosovo and began reconstruction of Suhadoll village.

2002 BTW Registered as a 501(c)3 NGO

2005-2010 Mugu and Humia districts of Nepal



This team installed smokeless stoves and solar lighting. Also began work in Ladakh among Nepalese children at serious risk of entering human trafficking.

2011 Hostel in Leh



BTW built a playground and the first official soccer pitch in Ladakh.

2012 Matho School



Reconstruction was started, a solar lighting system was installed, transportation was supplied for students and faculty, and school was repainted and refurbished.

2012 Matho School



The team replaced a roof on the school.

2013 Hostel in Leh



This team worked on projects with the nomadic people on the Tibetan Plateau, provided funding for the addition to the hostel dormitory and provided electrical wiring for the addition.

2014 Phey School



Repairs were made to schools on the Tibetan Plateau

The Values Course was taught to teachers and headmasters at the District Institute of Education and Training.

New desks were provided and repairs made to schools in the Ladakh area.

2015 Diggar



Repairs were done to the school building and a new roof installed. Kindles were gifted.

2016 Diggar



Repairs were made to the school building and a teaching seminar presented. Classroom and sports equipment, shoes and warm hats were gifted.

2018 Diggar



Roof construction and classroom remodeling was accomplished

2019 Puga



Roof repairs and Electrical work was completed, English conversation class taught and teaching materials and warm hats were gifted.

2019 Tangyar



School roof renovation was done and classes in English conversation taught.

2020 and 2021 Teams were not able to travel to India because of the Covid pandemic.
