## 2022 MISSIONS TRIPS TO NORTHERN INDIA\* - Beyond Tears Worldwide -

#### A GREAT OPPORTUNITY TO SERVE THE REMOTE NOMADIC PEOPLES OF NORTHERN INDIA

**Project Photoskar**: The village of Photoskar is located 165 km from Leh at an altitude of 4,750 mts (14,250 ft). This school is a Government Middle School of about 29 students of which 20 live as full-time residents at the school for about nine months of the academic year. The age level is from 3 to 14 and there are 4 or 5 students in each class. The staff total is 12 and these include administration and boarding school personnel. There are 11 teachers. These students move on to Khaltse Village School for higher education. Sports is an important feature of the school extracurricular activities and they play volleyball, cricket and soccer. The playground is located a ten-minute walk from the school. Our project will consist of renovating the roof of the school building and several outdoor toilets. Climate change and increases in rainfall are rapidly causing the disintegration of mud roofs and walls designed for desert conditions at altitude. The proposed date of this project is from **May 15 to June 03, 2022**. We anticipate the need of seven participants who have knowledge of general construction work. We will also supply the Boarding School Dormitories with matting. An English Language Values Program for the children has been approved and we will need three English as a Second Language (ESL) experienced teachers for the trip.

**Project Leh Hostel:** The village of Leh is host to a Hostel that has supported Nepali migrant workers' children for many years. These children would otherwise be neglected at the road construction tents or forced to engage in child labor if it was not for the care they receive at this non-profit boarding school. There are presently about 90 children ranging in age from 4 to 17 living there. A large concrete slab for year-round sports activities is the focus of the Project. We will need experienced workers in concrete to assist the local construction company hired to oversee the work. In addition, we will renovate the walls of the dormitories and repaint them after new drywall has been installed. We anticipate the need for eight volunteers who can hammer a nail or paint. As these construction and renovation projects are going on, we will also teach English, help with homework, teach ukulele, Scottish dance, photography and other activities. To support this English Value Program and the other activities, we will need a minimum of five volunteers. This project is scheduled for **July 23 to August 06, 2022**.

Participants must be in good general health. Applications for the Photoskar Project should be submitted by **April 15, 2022**, along with the non-refundable deposit and half of the funds due per person costs. The Leh Hostel project application should be submitted by **May 30, 2022**. A deposit of \$500 must be submitted with the application. The total amount of the project costs must be paid in full 30 days before the departure dates. \*Because of the Covid 19 virus, we are not sure we will be able to obtain the necessary visas to enter India even after a decision to go is finalized. Covid conditions can change at a moment's notice. We take the health of our participants seriously. These projects may have to be postponed until 2023. Paid fees can be applied to later projects if the 2022 projects do not take place. Thank you for your understanding. The status of the 2022 projects will be discussed at the March 2022 BTW Quarterly Board Meeting.
