MESSAGE FROM JAY COMFORT, BTW PRESIDENT

Solomon, among the wisest men who ever lived, wrote in Psalms 127:1, “Except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain who build it; except the Lord keeps the city, the watchman wakes but in vain.”

How true these words remain. Every human effort without God’s direction is hollow, but when the Lord is the builder, even the smallest seed can grow into something eternal.

From the very beginning of Beyond Tears Worldwide, Inc., we have sought to follow the leading of the Holy Spirit. Our prayer has always been that every step, every plan, every journey be ordained by God. - **“Build, Brew, Belong” (May 27– June 12)** - A renovation project at Café au Leh, transforming space into a haven of grace where conversations can lead to Christ.



These are not ordinary projects. They are sacred invitations and limited in scope both by time and members—to plant, to build, to speak life where few have heard. The fields are ready, the doors are open—but only for a short time. Those who feel the Spirit stirring within them will recognize that this is not coincidence—it is a calling.
